## INVESTS IN DESERVING YOUNG PEOPLE

The critical shortage of skilled maths and science teachers in South Africa has an overwhelmingly negative impact on the quality of education in the country. It means that students are often forced to enrol in courses that do not have maths or science as fundamental requirements, thus limiting their future career options.

Thuto Trust, an innovative education trust and registered Public Benefit Organisation (PBO) invests in deserving young people who are dedicated to become excellent maths and science teachers.

The Thuto Trust's teacher development programme provides comprehensive scholarships toward University Education Degrees, full-time practical teacher training through our partner schools, as well as leadership development and holistic psycho-social support initiatives.

Our investment is aimed at producing highly proficient teachers, creating career opportunities, and exponentially improving the long-term education outcomes in South Africa. Thuto's Teacher Development programme places emphasis on teaching from the early childhood development phase through to high school – particularly in literacy, maths and science.

Good teachers are the catalyst for lifelong learning in our children. Your investment at teacher level will empower young black students (the majority of whom are female) to become positive, productive members of society with a clear vision of what their future holds.

We strive to support highly motivated and tenacious students with a passion for teaching and a strong will to succeed, providing the means through this programme.
